POOL RULES AND REGULATIONS

1 - Pool capacity:

82 people. As a result, in the event of large crowds, access to the swimming pool may be temporarily suspended by the campsite staff.

2 - Opening times:

The campsite swimming pool is open from May to September, from 10am to 8pm.

The management reserves the right to change opening times or close the pool for technical, health or safety reasons.

3 - Attire and behaviour of users:

Swimwear is compulsory. Long shorts, Bermuda shorts and T-shirts may not be worn in the water.

The following are permitted: one or two-piece swimming costumes, swimming trunks and boxer shorts (sticky and above the knee), and for children under 5, lycra t-shirts and neoprene shorts are tolerated.

Users must remain correctly and decently dressed.

Any act or behaviour likely to offend decency, public decency, the peace and quiet of bathers, or the good order and cleanliness of the establishment, is strictly forbidden. It will be punished by immediate dismissal from the pool.

It is forbidden to operate radios, recorders or CD players and to take photographs without the consent of the persons concerned.

4 - Hygiene:

Animals are strictly forbidden in the pool area.

Showering and foot baths are compulsory on entering and leaving the pool.

It is forbidden to enter the pool wearing shoes. Please leave them in the shoe rack at the entrance.

Access to the pools is forbidden to people suffering from illnesses whose external effects may cause discomfort or contagion for others, as well as to people in an obvious state of uncleanliness.

It is forbidden to eat, drink, smoke, spit or throw rubbish in the pool area; rubbish bins are provided for this purpose.

Only young children who are 'clean' or wearing special nappies are allowed to swim.

All bathers are responsible for keeping the pool area clean and tidy.

5 - Responsibility and supervision:

Access to the swimming pool is free and strictly reserved for campsite customers, who must comply with the campsite rules. The pool is not supervised. Children under the age of 16 must be accompanied by at least one parent (or legal guardian) who is solely responsible for their supervision. The management cannot under any circumstances be held responsible in the event of an accident.

6 - Safety:

For their own safety, pool users are asked to comply with the internal rules.

It is forbidden to

- to annoy users by noisy, dangerous or immoral games or actions;
- push or throw people parked on the beaches into the water;
- running, shouting, diving or throwing water;
- simulating drowning;
- playing with balls on the beaches;
- using floating devices and lifebuoys;
- swimming with suntan oil on their bodies
- climbing fences and separations of any kind;

7 - Respect for the facilities:

It is forbidden to damage the facilities and installations. Any damage will be repaired at the offender's expense.

8 - Penalties:

Staff may exclude offenders from the pool at any time.

9 - Lost property:

The campsite is not insured against the loss or theft of jewellery, valuables or cash. Users are asked not to bring any valuables with them. Lost property must be handed in and/or claimed at the campsite reception.

10 - Closing:

The pool is closed 30 minutes before closing time.
